ACTION ITEMS

1. To close and dissolve Community Presbyterian Church of Crestline as a worshipping congregation effective May 20, 2018.
2. To approve the lease agreement with Crestline New Wine Christian Fellowship.

INFORMATION ITEMS

The final service of worship for Community Presbyterian Church of Crestline was held Sunday, May 20, 2018, with approximately 90 people celebrating its 80 years of ministry. At this service Moderator Kistner declared the congregation to be dissolved following the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper as the congregation's final act. The Rev. Dr. Tom Rennard preached. The service was followed by a fellowship dinner.

Our Administrative Commission is dealing with four buildings on three pieces of property in Crestline.

Property 1

The Church Building: We are moving toward a lease agreement with another congregation in the community. This conversation began in 2017 but was suspended by the session at the time they decided to ask Presbytery to appoint an AC.

The Office Building: The building, until recently, had tenets unanticipated by the AC. They have vacated the premises as of the middle of May. We are preparing this building for its future use whatever that may be.

Property 2

The A-Frame: Is currently rented through a local property management company.

Property 3

The Old Preschool Building: This building was sold in 2013 with the church holding the note. The buyers defaulted and the church never foreclosed. The AC is currently working towards foreclosure.
